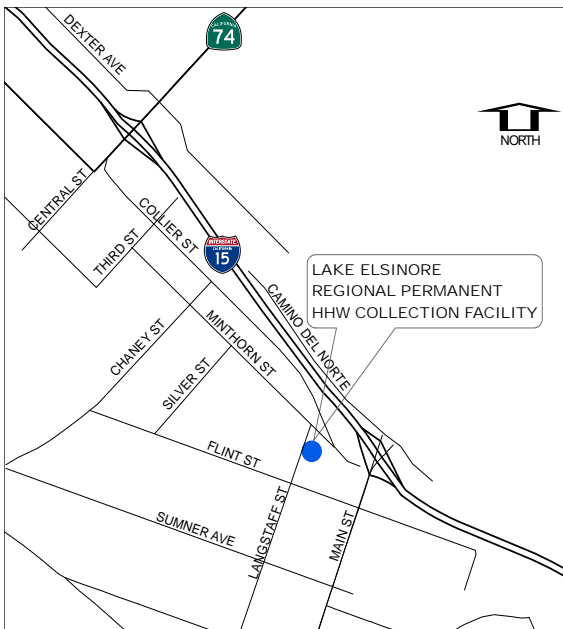


Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility

NOTE: Event may be cancelled due to rain, snow or excessive winds or other hazardous conditions as determined by County.

Location: City of Lake Elsinore Regional HHW Collection Facility*
City Public Works Yard, 512 North Langstaff Street
Lake Elsinore, CA 92530

*This facility is jointly operated by the City of Lake Elsinore and the Riverside County Waste Management Department.



Directions:

From north or south on I-15, exit at Main Street and travel west on Main Street to Sumner Avenue. Turn northwesterly on Sumner Avenue and go to Langstaff Street. Turn northeasterly on Langstaff Street. Proceed to end of street and facility entrance on right.

From State Hwy 74, travel southwest to Lakeshore Drive, proceeding on West Graham to Langstaff Street. Turn northeasterly on Langstaff Street and proceed to end of street. Facility entrance is on the right.

- ✓ **Household Hazardous Waste Only-No Business Waste**
- ✓ **Each load shall not exceed 5 gallons of liquid waste or a total of 50 pounds—Multiple trips are allowed**
- ✓ **Containers shall be marked and secured to prevent leaks**
- ✓ **Containers holding gasoline will not be returned**

Acceptable Items

- Used Oil and Filters
- Latex/Oil-Base Paint
- Fluorescent Tubes/Bulbs
- Pesticides
- Cleaners
- BBQ & Camp Size Propane
- Aerosol Cans
- Antifreeze
- Auto Batteries
- Garden Chemicals
- Pool Chlorine
- TVs and Computers
- Electronic Waste
- Sharps

Unacceptable Items

- Government, Business, Non-Profit, or Out-of-County Hazardous Waste
- Explosives or Ammunition
- Medical/Infectious Waste (except Sharps)
- Asbestos
- 55 Gallon Drums
- Appliances
