Directions:

From I-15, exit Murrieta Hot Springs Road and proceed west. Turn north on Jefferson Avenue to the transportation yard immediately on the left. Turn west into the facility entrance.

- ✓ **Each load shall not exceed 5 gallons of liquid waste or a total of 50 pounds—Multiple trips are allowed**
- ✓ **Containers shall be marked and secured to prevent leaks**
- ✓ **Containers holding gasoline will not be returned**

Unacceptable Items

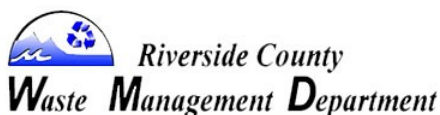
- Government, Business, Non-Profit, or Out-of-County Hazardous Waste
