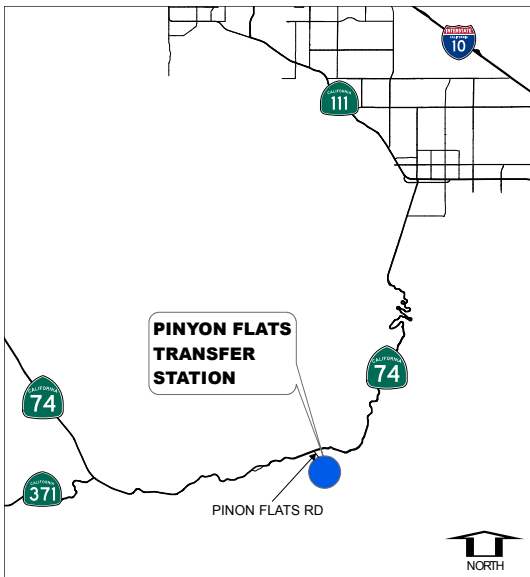


Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

NOTE: Event may be cancelled due to rain, snow or excessive winds or other hazardous conditions as determined by County.

Location: Pinyon Flats Transfer Station South End of Pinyon Flats Road Pinyon Pines, CA 92561



Directions:

From Highway 74 in Pinyon Pines area, turn south on Pinyon Flats Road, just west of the Fire Station at the crest of the hill. Enter event at end of road.

From I-10 in the Coachella Valley, take the Monterey Avenue south which becomes the "Palms to Pines Highway" (Hwy 74). Continue on State Highway 74 south bound then up into the mountains. Once the crest has been reached, pass the Fire Station and turn south onto Pinyon Flats Road. Enter event at end of road.

- ✓ **Household Hazardous Waste Only-No Business Waste**
- ✓ **Each load shall not exceed 5 gallons of liquid waste or a total of 50 pounds—Multiple trips are allowed**
- ✓ **Containers shall be marked and secured to prevent leaks**
- ✓ **Containers holding gasoline will not be returned**

- Used Oil and Filters
- Latex/Oil-Base Paint
- Fluorescent Tubes/Bulbs
- Pesticides
- Cleaners
- BBQ & Camp Size Propane
- Aerosol Cans
- Antifreeze
- Auto Batteries
- Garden Chemicals
- Pool Chlorine
- TVs and Computers
- Electronic Waste
- Sharps

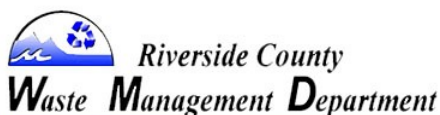
Unacceptable Items

- Government, Business, Non-Profit, or Out-of-County Hazardous Waste
- Explosives or Ammunition
- Medical/Infectious Waste (except Sharps)
- Asbestos
- 55 Gallon Drums
- Appliances
