Definition

Household batteries include single-use alkaline batteries such as AAA, AA, C, D and 9V; rechargeable nickel-cadmium, nickel-metal hydride, and lithium batteries. Rechargeable and single-use batteries both contain toxic and corrosive components that must be disposed of properly. Batteries can no longer be disposed of in regular trash. They can be recycled and made into new batteries.

Special Conditions

Batteries generated from business are not accepted at Riverside County Landfills.

Batteries generated from residents are accepted at all Department landfills for recycling only. Customers are directed to place these items in the recycling area in a manner that prevents breakage. Waste loads containing these items which are mixed with solid waste will be refused.

Riverside County Landfill Charges
