Definition

A waste tire is a tire which is no longer usable for its original intended purpose because of wear, damage, or defect or a tire which has been discarded or disposed of by its owner.

Special Conditions

Tires may be on or off rims. Residents and businesses who are not registered with the State of California as a commercial tire hauler may haul no more than 9 tires per trip. State law prohibits the transportation of more than 9 waste tires at a time by an unregistered hauler. Registered tire haulers must provide a State Tire Manifest to the Gate Services Assistant and have the Tire Hauler Registration Decal visible in their windshield.

Tires are accepted with the following restrictions:

- Tires cannot exceed 4 feet in diameter and/or 200 lbs each.
- Tires may not be delivered commingled with other solid waste. When tires arrive to the Department landfills comingled with other solid waste, the customer must separate them and place them in the designated tire storage area.
- Large loads of tires may be refused at any time to prevent the landfill from exceeding maximum storage of tires. Department landfills may not store more than 500 hundred tires at any one time. For this reason, commercial tire haulers should consider alternative facilities specializing in tire recycling. Information on where to find a permitted waste tire hauler and/or a tire disposal or recycling facility are listed on page 2 of this fact sheet.

- Lamb Canyon Landfill located at 16411 Lamb Canyon Road, Beaumont, CA 92223.
- Blythe Landfill located at 1000 Midland Road, Blythe, CA 92225.

If you have excessive amounts of tires your load may be refused and you may be referred to a tire recycling and/or disposal service provider.

Department Enforcement

The Department is required by State law to report information regarding unlicensed haulers who haul more than 9 tires into the landfill. Waste loads containing commingled tires may be refused at the customer's expense.

Extend the Life Span of Your Tires

- Check the air pressure in your tires at least once a month.
- Regularly check the tread depth of your tires.
- Rotate your tires every 6,000 miles as a rule of thumb.
- Practice good driving habits. Observe speed limits, steer clear of potholes and debris on the road.
- Finally, be alert to changes in vehicle handling, and look for uneven wear on your tires.
